SCCBC 2020 Race Supplementary Regulations for CACC Race Events

Your application/entry to the event constitutes acceptance of these Supplementary Regulations. The SCCBC Race Announcement and Schedule form part of these Supplementary Regulations. Infractions may result in penalty or exclusion at the discretion of the Steward.

- 1. All events are to be held on the 2.1 km Mission Raceway Park Road Course in a counter clockwise direction.
- Races Licenses accepted: CACC, Region licences from former ASN Canada FIA territories, ICSCC, SCCA or IMSA. Canadians require licenses issued by CACC or other former ASN Canadian territories.
- 3. All competitors, entrants, crewmembers and officials without evidence of having the CACC annual waiver, must sign and submit the Official CACC waiver prior to being admitted to the event. All signatories must wear the assigned wristband.
- 4. Minors (under 19) registered as crew, drivers or volunteers must have a parent or legal guardian sign an Annual Parental Waiver. **No one under the age of 16,** with the exception of registered licensed Junior drivers, is permitted in hot areas and may not be registered as crew.
- 5. Registration is located at the front gate. The official notice board is located in the tech area.
- No Smoking allowed in hot pits, Pre-grid or any Mission Raceway Park building.
- 7. No testing on any facility roadway. Racecars are permitted in the east parking area only for the purpose of loading
- 8. Prior to 10 minute before the 1st scheduled session each day, race engines may only be idled to warm, or to report to tech and to return to their paddock space.
- 9. All cars must report to Pre-Grid before entering, or re-entering the track from the paddock.
- 10. Cars arriving at Pre-Grid **must** turn their engines off until the 1 minute warning and if you arrive after the 5-minute warning for race sessions you may be put at the back of the grid.
- 11. Hot Pit speed limit is fifty (50) kilometers per hour (30 mph). Hot Pit lane ends at the Starters Tower.
- 12. Support vehicles must be parked within the confines of assigned Paddock space areas.
- 13. No skateboards, scooters or roller blades in the Paddock. **No one under 16 is allowed to operate a motorized vehicle** (exception: drivers holding a Junior CACC license). No one under 16 is allowed to ride a bicycle in the paddock until after the Final Checkered Flag of the day and all cars are off the track.
- 14. Both Front paved lanes in the paddock area run eastbound from 10 minutes before 1st scheduled session. Rear lane is two ways. Speed limit: SLOW
- 15. Do not use the Paddock Lanes to load until cars from last session of the day have returned to their paddock spaces.
- 16. Fueling is permitted in the Paddock only.
- 17. Report all hazardous waste spills to the Paddock Marshall. Anyone dumping oil will be **fined and banned**. Drivers will be assessed a cost of \$50 per bag for any grease sweep required for fluid leaks or spills anywhere on the facility.
- 18. Damage to track, grounds, buildings or equipment, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Damage to paved areas may result in fines. Protect the asphalt from damage by jacks, jack stands, poles, etc.
- 19. Do not plug anything into any facility power outlet without the written permission of the SCCBC President.
- 20. No generators may exceed 80 decibels (dB) from 7:00am to 11:00pm. No generators from 11:00pm to 7:00am.
- 21. No open fires anywhere.
- 22. Overnight camping at the track Sunday night with permission only, please contact the SCCBC President.
- 23. Racecars may not exceed 95 decibels (dB) measured at 50 ft. from the racing surface. Cars exceeding the dB limit will be meatballed and must affect a repair prior to re-entering the track. Racecars exceeding the db limit in a qualifying session will have all prior qualifying times in that session deleted.
- 24. All pets must be under control and confined or on a reasonable length leash while on site.
- 25. Upon exiting the Hot Pit, stay in the dedicated pit-out lane to Turn 1.
- 26. Tire scrubbing is **only** permitted behind the Pace Car.
- 27. All Race Participants and their race/support vehicles must vacate the premises 90 minutes after the checkered flag on the final day of each event.
- 28. Racecars failing to negotiate Turn 1 that do not pass the commitment line may re-enter safely at Turn 1. Racecars past the commitment line must reenter safely at Turn 3. No positional or lap time advancement is permitted.
- 29. Racecars using the run-off road in Turn 4 must come to a stop prior to Turn Station 6 and wait for direction from a Turn Marshall prior to re-entering the track. No positional or lap time advancement is permitted.
- 30. Racecars exiting the racing surface in 7A or 7B must re-enter the track only when safe to do so. No positional or lap time advancement is permitted.
- 31. Drivers may not short cut the corners by crossing over curbs. Intentional wheel(s) on the inside of curbing; during qualifying will result in no time for session; during race will result in a 20 second time penalty for each. Decisions by the CACC Steward(s) are not subject to appeal.
- 32. Racecars intending to exit the track via pit entrance must enter the pit lane at the beginning of the pit entrance line in Turn 9 and stay four wheels to the right of the line for its entire length. Vehicles not exiting the track must not place four wheels to the right of the pit entrance line in Turn 9
- 33. There is no access to Race Control without the permission of Race Control. There is no access to the PA stand except for authorized observers and event personnel.
- 34. The SCCBC reserves the right to, at their discretion, refuse entry and/or access and/or remove participants from the Mission Raceway Park.
- 35. No moving into the facility prior to the announced schedule time unless approved by the President.
- 36. Live broadcasting is not allowed during the event. This includes Facebook Live, Periscope, etc.
- 37. With the permission of the Steward SCCBC reserves the right to shorten sessions and/or combine groups.
- 38. RULES REGARDING COVID-19 PROTOCAL ARE POSTED SEPARATELY AND WILL BE ENFORCED. THOSE NOT COMPLYING WILL BE FINED OR EXPELLED.

SCCBC Covid-19 Protocol for All Participants:

- All participants, including volunteers, must pre-register. Only pre-registered persons will be granted access to the
 event.
- One crew person per driver.
- Entry to the road course if there is a line outside the entry gate, please remain in your vehicle. The entrance booth will be manned, but the window will be closed. Only drivers, registered crew members, volunteers, marshals, safety crew, and SCCBC executive will be permitted to enter. Each person will receive a wrist band at the gate.
- All participants MUST present a Covid-19 self-declaration at the gate. Please do not come to the track if you are not feeling well or have been in contact with someone else who is ill. If you begin to feel unwell when on site please report it to an official and isolate yourself. COMPLETE THE FORM ON YOUR DAY OF ARRIVAL, show it to the gate person and drop it in the box on the table next to the booth.
- Physical distancing and safety protocols the practice of physical distancing will be expected on-site. Please maintain
 at least 2 m or 6 ft. between yourself and anyone else, including the members of your crew, who is not part of your
 household or social bubble. The wearing of a non-medical mask or face covering IS REQUIRED when in any building or
 common area including any area outside of your own paddock space. Frequent hand washing, for 20 seconds, is
 encouraged for all.
- **Tech** SELF TECH is in effect for this event. A club official will visit your paddock to do a tech inspection spot-check on your car. Keep at least 6 feet away while he is in your paddock. Self tech forms are included in the package available on the SCCBC calendar page. Complete your form electronically, or write legibly, print out the form and display it predominately on your car or in your paddock space.
- **Drivers' meetings** will take place outside with appropriate spacing between drivers and with the speaker using a megaphone or the PA system.
- **Pre-Grid** –**A non-medical mask or face covering must be worn**. Crews are discouraged from going into pre-grid unless absolutely necessary and must keep their distance from other crews and drivers. **Drivers must arrive in pregrid with their race gear on, including balaclavas/helmets** or a face mask.
- Transponders if you require a transponder complete the rental form that is included in the package on the SCCBC website and email it to registrar@sccbc.net. Pay for the transponder on your MSR registration form. The transponder will be available for pick up in the tech area. Touch only the one with your name on it. Return it to the same place.
- **Grandstands** Any persons using the grandstands must maintain at least 2 meters between themselves and others at all times. The paddock grandstand is considered to be part of the paddock and masks must be worn.
- Washrooms The washroom building will be frequently sanitized by our attendant. Please respect the signs that indicate
 the washroom is closed for cleaning and keep your distance when entering and leaving the building. One person at a
 time please. The portable restrooms will be cleaned and serviced before and after each event day by our vendor. There
 will be a hand wash trailer located in the tech area. Please was your hands frequently.
- **Paddock**: do not walk through other drivers' paddock spaces. Use the roadways. Wear a mask if you are visiting someone else's paddock space.
- Garbage: Cans will not be provided. Participants may put their refuse in the dumpster or take it with them.
- Overnight camping in the paddock: Participants must indicate their intentions in the appropriate MS Registration field. Friday night is allowed for entrants who are running on Saturday, or on both days. Saturday night camping is allowed for Sunday entrants. .
- **Lunch**: There will NOT be any onsite food services. Please bring your own lunch and practice social distancing during the lunch break.
- **End of Race Day**: Entrants not racing the following day are expected to pack up and vacate the paddock within 90 minutes after the end of their last session.
- We strongly recommend:
 - Each participant/volunteer to bring his/her own mask, gloves and disinfectant. The club will have backup masks for the volunteers should they need another, and disposable gloves for the volunteers.
 - o Drivers and crews should plan to spend the majority of your time in your own paddock space.
 - o Do not share tools and equipment with other participants
 - When socializing at the end of the day please respect the Covid-19 rules.



Covid19 Health Declaration

Please read the following document carefully. It must be signed and dated on the day it is submitted in person at check-in. It is to reflect your current state of health at the time of the event.

Everyone who will be attending the facility will be required to submit this form. Failure to submit will result in denied access to the facility with no refund of entry fees. Multiple people of your party can be on one form.

- I am fully aware of any risks and attend the race at my own risk as either a driver, driver assist person or SCCBC support worker/volunteer.
