CACC Race #3 – Solstice Heats

June 20 - 21, 2026

This championship points race event is sanctioned by CACC and is conducted under the 2026 CACC regulations. It is organized by the Sports Car Club of British Columbia at the Mission Raceway Park Road Course in Mission, BC. Each regional group will have one race on Saturday and two races on Sunday, and Vintage on Sunday.

Race results will be posted on the notice board in Tech.

There is no Friday Practice. Cars can be dropped off from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM Friday.

Cancellation Policy: If you need to cancel, please update your entry. If you break on Saturday and cannot run Sunday, you must cancel your Sunday entry by emailing registrar@sccbc.net with your request by 9am on Sunday, or see Pam Stec at the track, in order to be issued a refund for Sunday's entry. No refunds will be issued after that time, however, a track credit may be offered.

All Race Entries MUST be completed in MotorSportReg.com. A credit card is required to register; however, your credit card will *not* be charged until you check in on the race weekend. All prices are CAD and include GST.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED. NO REGISTRATION AT THE TRACK.

Check-in is at the paddock gate tent where you will receive a wrist band.

CHECK-IN IS OPEN FROM 5:00pm to 7:00pm on Fri and 7:00am to 9:00am on Saturday & Sunday

There will be a \$100 surcharge for anyone checking in after 9am on Sat or Sun.

TRANSPONDERS: Weekend rental \$70.00 for 2 days or \$40.00 for 1 day. **You must complete the new online [Transponder Rental Form](#) by midnight on the Wednesday prior to the race event or you will delay your check-in. Failure to have the correct transponder number registered to your car will result in no practice times being posted, and you will not be allowed to qualify or race until it is corrected.** You may be black flagged during your session.

Notes: - Vehicles in timed sessions must have an operational AMB TranX260 or MYLAPS Car Classic, Flex or Direct Power transponder.

- Open to vehicles eligible under current CACC, SCCA, or ICSCC regulations

- All Canadian participants must hold a valid CACC or recognized Canadian license

Paved Paddock Spaces: Paddock reservations are made with your registration on MotorsportReg.com before the race entry deadline. Please indicate your 1st, 2nd and 3rd choices. They will be assigned in the order the entries are received. If your entry is late or you do not indicate your choices, your pit assignment will be determined at registration from any remaining. The back row will be allocated to pre-approved trailers first. **DO NOT OCCUPY paddock spaces that have not been assigned to you by the [Paddock Marshal](#).** Violators may be fined and/or towed.

SCCBC 2026 Race Supplementary Regulations for CACC Race Events

Your application/entry to the event constitutes acceptance of these Supplementary Regulations. The SCCBC Race Announcement and Schedule form part of these Supplementary Regulations. Infractions may result in penalty or exclusion at the discretion of the Steward.

1. All competitors, entrants, crew members, and officials without evidence of having the CACC annual waiver, must sign and submit the Official CACC waiver prior to being admitted to the event. All signatories must wear the assigned wristband.
2. Minors (under 19) registered as crew, drivers or volunteers must have a parent or legal guardian sign an Annual Parental Waiver. **No one under the age of 16**, with the exception of registered licensed Junior drivers, is permitted in hot areas and may not be registered as crew.
3. Registration is located in the tent located by pre-grid and the washrooms. The official notice board is located in the tech area.
4. **No Smoking** allowed in hot pits, Pre-grid or any Mission Raceway Park building.
5. No testing on any facility roadway. Racecars are permitted in the east parking area only for the purpose of loading or unloading.
6. Prior to 10 minutes before the 1st scheduled session each day, race engines may only be idled to warm, or to report to tech and to return to their paddock space.
7. All cars must report to Pre-Grid before entering or re-entering the track from the paddock.
8. Cars arriving at Pre-Grid **must** turn their engines off until the 1-minute warning. If you arrive after the 5-minute warning for race sessions, you may be put at the back of the grid. Racers who are in a split start session will be placed at the back of their respective group within the split session.
9. Hot Pit speed limit is fifty (50) kilometers per hour (30 mph). Hot Pit lane ends at the Starters Tower.
10. Support vehicles must be parked within the confines of assigned Paddock space areas.
11. No skateboards or roller blades in the Paddock.
12. **No one under 16 is allowed to operate a motorized vehicle** (exception: drivers holding a Junior CACC license). No one under 16 is allowed to ride a bicycle or scooter in the paddock until after the Final Checkered Flag of the day and all cars are off the track.
13. Helmets are strongly recommended for everyone operating any type of motorized bike, scooter, cart and are required for anyone under 16 operating any bike or scooter.
14. Speed limit for bikes, scooters, motorized/electric or analog is 10 km/h in the paddock. One way lanes apply.
15. Both Front paved lanes in the paddock area run eastbound from 10 minutes before 1st scheduled session. Rear lane is two ways. Speed limit: **SLOW**
16. **Do not use the Paddock Lanes** to load until cars from last session of the day have returned to their paddock spaces.
17. Fueling is permitted in the Paddock only.
18. Report all hazardous waste spills to the Paddock Marshall. Anyone dumping oil will be **finned and banned**. Drivers will be assessed a cost of \$50 per bag for any grease sweep required for fluid leaks or spills anywhere on the facility.
19. Damage to track, grounds, buildings, or equipment, regardless of cause, will be charged to the driver responsible. Damage to paved areas may result in fines. Protect the asphalt from damage by jacks, jack stands, poles, etc.
20. Do not plug anything into any facility power outlet without the written permission of the SCCBC President.
21. No generators may exceed 80 decibels (db) from 7:00am to 11:00pm. No generators from 11:00pm to 7:00am.
22. No wood fires anywhere. Propane fire pits may be used **after** the final session of the day. **They must be a safe distance from stored fuel.**
23. Racecars may not exceed 100 decibels (db) measured at 50 ft. from the racing surface. Cars exceeding the db limit will be meatballed and must affect a repair prior to re-entering the track. Racecars exceeding the db limit in a qualifying session will have all prior qualifying times in that session deleted.
24. All pets must be under control and confined or on a reasonable length leash at all times while on site.
25. Upon exiting the Hot Pit, stay in the dedicated pit-out lane to Turn 1.
26. Tire scrubbing is **only** permitted behind the Pace Car.
27. All Race Participants and their race/support vehicles must vacate the premises 90 minutes after the checkered flag on the final day of each event.
28. Racecars failing to negotiate Turn 1 that **do not pass** the commitment line may re-enter safely at Turn 1. Racecars **past the commitment line** must re-enter safely at Turn 3. No positional or lap time advancement is permitted.
29. Racecars using the run-off road in Turn 4 must come to a stop prior to Turn Station 6 and wait for direction from a Turn Marshall prior to re-entering the track. No positional or lap time advancement is permitted.
30. Racecars exiting the racing surface in 7A or 7B must re-enter the track only when safe to do so. No positional or lap time advancement is permitted.
31. Drivers may not cut the corners by crossing over curbs on either side. Intentional wheel(s) on the inside or outside of curbing; during qualifying will result in a loss of 5 overall grid positions for each occurrence; during race will result in a 20 second time penalty for each. Decisions by the CACC Steward(s) are not subject to appeal.
32. When a yellow flag is displayed in turn 3, and the next manned turn station is turn 6 and it is displaying a green flag, drivers must not resume race speed or pass until they are adjacent to the turn 6 flag station.
33. Racecars intending to exit the track via pit entrance must enter the pit lane at the beginning of the pit entrance line in Turn 9 and stay

four wheels to the right of the line for its entire length. Vehicles not exiting the track must not place four wheels to the right of the pit entrance line in Turn 9

34. There is no access to Race Control without the permission of Race Control. There is no access to the PA stand except for authorized observers and event personnel.
35. The SCCBC reserves the right to, at their discretion, refuse entry and/or access and/or remove participants from the Mission Raceway Park.
36. No overnight camping at the track Sunday night.
37. No moving into the facility prior to the announced schedule time unless approved by the President.
38. Live broadcasting without permission is not allowed during the event. This includes YouTube, Facebook Live, Periscope, etc.
39. With the permission of the Steward SCCBC reserves the right to shorten sessions and/or combine groups.
40. Split Starts. Classes within certain run groups may organized into Split Starts. The grid will be set by lap time with a select class grouping at the back ordered by lap time within that class. In Closed Wheel 2, Spec Miatas will start behind the other classes in order of qualifying times. In Open Wheel 2, Legends will start behind the other classes in order of qualifying times. The starting procedure for the lead group is unchanged. The second group will be led by the top qualifying car in the select class and will pace that group to the second green flag. In the event of a waved off start of the second group, a full course yellow will be shown and the pace car will be deployed for a single file restart as one group. Classes selected for split starts will be identified and confirmed at the drivers meeting by the Steward.
